



The venue ist not very accessible by public transport. Therefore we have set up a shuttle service from the U2 station "Donaustadtbrücke" or the Park and Ride "Donaustadtbrücke" and back.

If you arrive by car build a carpool if it's possible. There are no parking spaces on site. The nearest parking area is at the Park and Ride "Donaustadtbrücke". Parking along the "Raffineriestrasse" is only possible with a valid parking ticket and only to a limited extent.
